

Admission Requirements

To apply for admission to a graduate program, the applicant should submit the following documents. After these documents are submitted, a consultation with the admissions counselor will be scheduled to determine a degree plan:

- (1.) A completed application
- (2.) Official transcripts
- (3.) Copy of teaching license (Master of Education in Reading, Master of Education in Instructional Leadership, Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Instructional Leadership, and Certificate of Advanced Study in Reading only).
- (4.) Consultation

Transfer Credits

Students may transfer in up to nine (9) graduate credits

For the Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 semester, the tuition rate is \$620 for students beginning an MAT or MED program, \$580 per credit hour for the Adult Undergraduate education programs, and \$720 per credit hour for the Applied Behavioral Analysis programs.

Full-time teachers at Catholic schools are offered a 50% tuition reduction.
