## **Admission Requirements**

It is in your best interest to complete your admission file as quickly as possible. Admission to the graduate program is determined by Graduate Committee. If an applicant meets all the admission criteria, the file will be reviewed by faculty member(s) who represent each department generally within 7-10 business days of your graduate admission file becoming complete. Admission to graduate school depends on several factors including a completed application, cumulative GPA, official transcripts, statement of purpose, resume, and 2 reference forms.
